Box 308, Mendenhall, MS 39114 or may be delivered, but must be received in the Simpson County Board of Supervisors Office or the Board meeting room at 111 West Pine Ave., Mendenhall, MS 39114, no later than 10:00 a.m., Monday, June 7, 2010. The mash feedmill, consisting of buildings, structures, equipment and other material, scrap and debris must be removed from the property within 45 days of bid acceptance. A 15 day extension may be requested for good reason. The county will demolish the concrete foundation after other items have been removed.
